Tennessee Covid-19 Update

Wearing a face mask has been proven to reduce the risk of being exposed to Covid-19 by more than 33%. It is one of the only tools you have to defend yourself from the virus.

On July 1st, Tennessee and Hamilton county both reported the largest single day increase in confirmed cases. In the month of June, the death rate from Coronavirus nearly doubled in Hamilton county.
